



Tournament Location

Come join us in Hanger 30 at the beautiful 350-acre Magnuson Park for a weekend of flyball! Not only will there be lots of racing, but Magnuson offers a great off leash dog park with water access, along with fishing, boating, swimming and much more.

- **Park Address:** 7400 Sand Point Way NE, Seattle, WA 98115
- Enter park through the 74th St. entrance.
- Parking can be found in the designated areas on 65th street or a large parking lot on 77th st.



Driving Directions

From Interstate 5, exit via N.E. 45th Street (Exit #169) or N.E. 65th Street (Exit #171)

- **From the N.E. 45th Street exit**, go east on 45th, past the University of Washington, and down the 45th Street ramp. Continue east past University Village Shopping Center. Bear left and continue about 2 miles. You will pass Children's Hospital and Regional Medical Center and Sand Point Village/Princeton Avenue.
- **From the I-5 N.E. 65th Street exit**, head east approximately four miles on 65th (stay on the arterial!) until you have crossed Sand Point Way N.E. into the N.E. 65th Street entrance to Warren G. Magnuson Park.

From State Route 520 (SR520), westbound towards Seattle

- Take the Montlake Boulevard exit (north) and continue north about 1 mile.
- Bear to the right as Montlake Boulevard becomes NE 45th Street, continue past University Village Shopping Center.
- Continue east through the NE 45th/Union Bay Place intersection. As the street bears to the left and north, it then becomes Sand Point Way NE.
- Continue on Sand Point Way NE about 2 miles, you will pass Children's Hospital and Regional Medical Center and Sand Point Village/Princeton Avenue.

From Interstate 90 (I-90), westbound towards Seattle

- Take Interstate 5 north about and continue about 4.5 miles to Exit #169, NE 45th Street.
- At the stoplight, turn right onto NE 45th Street and continue east about 1.5 miles, passing the University of Washington campus and heading down a steep hill.
- At the bottom of the hill, turn left at the stoplight and continue east on NE 45th Street.
- NE 45th Street will bear left and become Sand Point Way NE.
- Continue on Sand Point Way NE about 2 miles, you will pass Children's Hospital and Regional Medical Center and Sand Point Village/Princeton Avenue.

You can also use any online map provider to get exact directions from your location.





Hotel Information

There are a variety of hotels in the area that are pet friendly, and here are some of the closest ones for you to check out.

RV Parking

Fortunately, the Seattle Parks and Recreation department granted our request to allow overnight RV parking (no tents allowed). Overnight RV parking will be allowed in the north parking lot during the tournament providing certain rules are followed:

- Campfires or other fires are not allowed.
- No alcohol sale or consumption.
- No loud music or other noises that would disrupt the Seattle noise ordinance.
- No littering during and after the event. Please keep the area clean!!

RV campers must be aware of two low underpasses on the approach to the Hanger 30 site. First the 74th Street entrance is 12'6". Another underpass is located at the NOAA access road just before Hanger 27. It is 16'1". Any RVs higher than these underpasses should use the 65th St. entrance, and come north on either 62nd St. or Sportsfield Drive. Please see the map available on our website for more detail!

If there is not enough room in the north lot, there are additional options for overnight RV parking. There is a KOA campground located in Kent (253-872-8652), as well as the Blue Sky RV Park located just off I-90 for overnight RV camping (www.blueskypreston.com).





Restaurants and Shopping

There are a variety of restaurants, food vendors and shopping near Magnuson Park. Many of them are located in and around University Village which is about 3 miles south of the venue. There are also some restaurants and grocery shopping in the Wedgwood neighborhood, also located just a few miles from the venue.

- Restaurants around University Village include: Ben and Jerry's, Starbucks, The Ram Brewery, Johnny Rockets, Jamba Juice, and World Wrapps. There's also a QFC and Safeway nearby for grocery shopping.
- Restaurants around Wedgwood and Northgate Mall include: Subway, Starbucks, Wedgwood Broiler, Jet City Pizza, Taco Del Mar, Red Robin, Olive Garden, and Top Pot Doughnut.
- Shopping in the area around University Village includes: Anne Taylor, Banana Republic, Barnes and Noble, Pottery Barn, Crate and Barrel, Bartell Drugs, Eddie Bauer, Gap, The North Face, and the Apple Store.
- Also check out Northgate Mall which has Target, Macy's, Nordstrom, Best Buy, and JC Penny's.



Other Events

The Gay Pride Parade and festivities will also be held this weekend. Most of the festivities will be in the Capital Hill and downtown Seattle areas.



Points of Interest

There are many interesting things to see around Seattle including checking out Discovery Park, Gas Works Park, The Seattle Center, Pike Place Market, Pioneer Square and much more. All of these places are dog friendly, if leashed!
